

DUNKERTON CITY COUNCIL met in special session, **November 28, 2018**, in the City Hall Council Chambers with Mayor Jessen presiding. The meeting was called to order at 5:32 p.m. Council members present: Mark Lichty, Bill Richard, Tina Dalton and Tom DeLong. Quorum present.

Moved by DeLong, seconded by Lichty to approve the agenda as written.

The Council discussed a bid from Robert C. Hauptly Construction regarding two concrete foundations for the River Walking Trail bridge. The bid includes excavation, forming, rebar, insulation of concrete to prevent freezing, form removal, and installation of  $\frac{3}{4}$  inch anchors. Cost of each foundation is \$3,075 for a total cost of \$6,150 for the project.

Mayor Jessen informed the Council that he had contacted 3 additional firms - Webb Concrete, Kite Construction and Trueg Custom Concrete. All stated they could not complete a project until well into next year; therefore, did not submit proposals.

Mayor Jessen also commented that if the two bridge abutments could be installed yet this year, the ground may be frozen enough for the bridge to be placed. Bart Brothers has offered to move the bridge if the weather permits.

Moved by DeLong, seconded by Lichty to approve the bid from Robert C. Hauptly Construction for the construction of 2 concrete bridge foundations up to \$6,150 for the River Walking Trail bridge. Ayes: Dalton, Lichty, Richard, and DeLong. Motion carried.

With no further discussion, Lichty / Dalton to adjourn at 5:43 pm.
