

DUNKERTON CITY COUNCIL met in special session, **February 20, 2020**, in the City Hall Council Chambers with Mayor Schares presiding. The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. Council members present: Monica Smith, Mark Lichty, Bill Richard, Ron Reichen and Brian Roquet. Quorum present.

Unless otherwise noted, all actions were passed by affirmative and unanimous vote of the council members present.

Moved by Roquet, seconded by Lichty to approve the agenda as written.

Moved by Lichty, seconded by Reichen to approve the lowest bid of \$38,746 from Stew Hansen Chrysler Dodge for a 3500HD pickup truck with a plow for the public works department. Additional bids received from Woodhouse Chevrolet and Karl Chevrolet. Woodhouse Chevrolet's bid was \$45,720.55 for a 3500HD truck with plow. Karl Chevrolet's bid was \$29,665.60 for a basic 3500HD truck with no plow attached.

The Council discussed revenue and expenses for the FY2021 budget.

Moved by Reichen, seconded by Roquet to approve publication of the proposed budget with the approved maximum levy rate of \$9.19.

Mayor Schares stated the City had a Workman's Comp Audit today and all went well. The Auditor had a few recommendations for the fire station which Mayor Schares will address with Fire Chief Manahl.
